NOTIFICATION

In exercise of the powers conferred by the provision to article 309 of the Constitution of India, read with the Notification No. F.5/4/65-GP, dated 11th January, 1965 of the Ministry of Home Affairs, Government of India, New Delhi, and in supersession of the Notification issued vide No.17843/Dev/P.W./E./64, dt. 31.01.1966, subsequent amendment in Notification No.1886/Dev./P.W./E./66, dt.20.10.1967 and under G.O. Ms.No.28, dt.08.08.1986 Published as supplement to the Gazette No.45 of 11.11.1986, save as respects things done or omitted to be done before such supersession, the Lieutenant Governor of Puducherry hereby makes the following Rules regulating the method of recruitment to the Group "B" Gazetted post of Assistant Engineer(Civil) in the Public Works Department, Puducherry, namely:-

1. Short title and commencement.-

- (1) These rules may be called the Government of Puducherry, Public Works Department, Group 'B' (Technical-Gazetted) Post of "Assistant Engineer (Civil)(including Engineer Assistant)"Recruitment Rules, 2017.
- (2) They shall come into force on and from the date of its publication in the official gazette.

2. Number of posts, their classification and Level in the Pay Matrix.- The number of the said post, its classification and Level in the Pay Matrix attached thereto shall be as specified in columns 2 to 4 of the said Schedule.

3. Method of recruitment, age limit and other qualifications.- The method of recruitment to the said post, age limit, qualifications and other matters relating thereto, shall be as specified in columns 5 to 13 of the said Schedule.

4. Disqualifications.-No person,-

- (a) who has entered into or contracted a marriage with a person having a spouse living; or
- (b) who, having a spouse living, has entered into or contracted a marriage with any person, shall be eligible for appointment to the said post:

Provided that the Lieutenant-Governor may, if satisfied that such marriage is permissible under the personal law applicable to such person and other party to the marriage and there are other grounds for so doing, exempt any person from the operation of this rule.

5. Power to relax.- Where the Lieutenant-Governor is of the opinion that it is necessary or expedient so to do, he may, by order, for reasons to be recorded in writing, relax any of the provisions of these rules with respect to any class or category of persons.

6. Savings.- Nothing in these rules shall affect the reservations, relaxations in upper age limit, and other concessions required to be provided for the scheduled castes, the scheduled tribes and other special categories of persons in accordance with the orders issued by the Government from time to time in this regard.

RECRUITMENT RULES FOR THE POST ASSISTANT ENGINEER (CIVIL)

1.	Name of the post	:	Assistant Engineer (Civil) (including Engineer Assistant)
2.	Number of posts	:	69 (Sixty nine) 2017 Subject to variation, dependent on work load
3.	Classification	:	General Central Services – Group 'B' – Gazetted – Non-Ministerial.
4.	Level in the Pay Matrix	:	Level-7 in the Pay Matrix.
5.	Whether selection or non-selection post	:	Selection
6.	Age limit for direct recruits	:	Between 18 and 30 years. (Relaxable for Govt. Servants in accordance with the orders or instructions issued by the Central Government from time to time). Note: The crucial date for determining the age limit shall be the closing date for receipt of applications from candidates in India (and not the closing date prescribed for those in Assam, Meghalaya, Arunachal Pradesh, Mizoram, Manipur, Nagaland, Tripura, Sikkim, Ladakh Division of Jammu and Kashmir State, Lahaul and Spiti Districts and Pangi Sub Division of Chamba District of Himachal Pradesh, Andaman and Nicobar Islands and Lakshadweep)
7.	Educational and other qualifications required for direct recruits	:	Essential: (i) Degree in Civil Engineering from a recognized University (ii) 2 years professional experience in the relevant field. Note 1: Qualification are relaxable at the discretion of the Union Public Service Commission in case of candidates otherwise well qualified. Note 2: The qualification regarding experience is/are relaxable at the discretion of the Union Public Service Commission in the case of candidates belonging to scheduled castes and scheduled tribes if at any stage of selection the Union Public Service Commission is of the opinion that sufficient number of candidates from these communities possessing the requisite experience are not likely to be available to fill the vacancy reserved for them.
8.	Whether age and educational qualifications prescribed for direct recruits will apply in the case of promotions	:	Age: No Educational Qualification: No

9.	Period of probation, if any	:	Two years (for Direct Recruitment)
10.	Method of recruitment whether by direct recruitment or by promotion or by deputation/absorption of the post to be filled by various methods	:	By promotion failing which by Direct Recruitment.

In case of recruitment by promotion/deputation/absorption grades from which promotion/deputation/absorption is to be made	:	<p>Promotion</p> <p>The Junior Engineer (Civil) in level 6 of the Pay Matrix with 5 years in the grade rendered after appointment thereto on regular basis and have successfully undergone Departmental/ Institutional short term training, conducted by the State/Central Government Organisation/ Institutions.</p> <p>Note 1:</p> <p>Where Juniors who have completed their qualifying/ eligibility service are being considered for promotion, their seniors would also be considered provided they are not short of the requisite qualifying/ eligibility service by more than half of such qualifying/or eligibility service or two years, whichever is less, and have successfully completed their probation period for promotion to the next higher grade along with their juniors who have already completed such qualifying/ eligibility service.</p> <p>Note 2:</p> <p>For the purpose of computing minimum qualifying service for promotion, the service rendered on a regular basis by an officer prior to 01.01.2006. The date from which the revised pay structure based on the 6th Central Pay Commission recommendations has been extended, shall be deemed to be service rendered in the corresponding Grade Pay/ Pay Scale extended based on the recommendations of the Pay Commission.</p>
