NOTIFICATION

In exercise of the powers conferred by the provision to article 309 of the Constitution of India, read with the Notification No. F.5/4/65-GP, dated the 11th January, 1965 of the Ministry of Home Affairs, Government of India, New Delhi, and in supersession of the Notification issued under G.O.Ms.No.8, dated 13th February 2003 of the Local Administration and Public Works Department (Public Works Wing), Puducherry and published in the supplement to the Official Gazette No.10, dated the 11th March 2003, in so far as it relates to the post of Water Analyst, save as respects things done or omitted to be done before such supersession, the Lieutenant Governor of Puducherry hereby makes the following Rules regulating the method of Recruitment to Group 'B' posts of Water Analyst in the Public Works Department, Puducherry, namely:-

1. Short title and commencement.-

- (1) These rules may be called the Government of Puducherry, Public Works Department, Group 'B' (Non-Gazetted Non-Ministerial) Post of "Water Analyst" Recruitment Rules, 2017.
- (2) They shall come into force on and from the date of its publication in the official gazette.

2. Number of posts, its classifications and Level in the Pay Matrix .- The number of the said post, its classification and the Level in the Pay Matrix attached thereto shall be as specified in columns 2 to 4 of the said Schedule annexed hereto.

3. Method of recruitment, age limit and other qualifications.- The method of recruitment to the said post, age limit, qualifications and other matters relating thereto, shall be as specified in columns 5 to 13 of the said Schedule.

4. Disqualifications.-No person,-

- (a) who has entered into or contracted a marriage with a person having a spouse living; or
- (b) who, having a spouse living, has entered into or contracted a marriage with any other person,

shall be eligible for appointment to the said post:

Provided that the Lieutenant-Governor may, if satisfied that such marriage is permissible under the personal law applicable to such person and other party to the marriage and there are other grounds for so doing, exempt any person from the operation of this rule.

5. Power to relax.- Where the Lieutenant-Governor is of the opinion that it is necessary or expedient so to do, he may, by order, for reasons to be recorded in writing, relax any of the provisions of these rules with respect to any class or category of persons.

6. Savings.- Nothing in these rules shall affect the reservations, relaxations in upper age limit, and other concessions required to be provided for the Scheduled Castes and other special categories of persons in accordance with the orders issued by the Government from time to time in this regard.
