NOTIFICATION

In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to article 309 of the Constitution of India, read with the Notification No. F.24/78/68-DS(II), dated the 24th September 1968 of the Ministry of Home Affairs, Government of India, New Delhi and in supersession of the Notification issued in G.O.Ms.No.34, dated 11th December 1996 of Local Administration and Public Works Department (Public Works Wing), Government of Pondicherry and published in Supplement to Gazette No.1 of the 7th January 1997, save as respects things done or omitted to be done before such supersession, the Lieutenant-Governor, Pondicherry hereby makes the following rules, regulating the method of recruitment to the Group 'A' post of Chief Engineer in the Public Works Department, Pondicherry, namely:-

1. *Short title and commencement.*--- (1) These rules may be called the Government of Pondicherry, Public Works Department, Group 'A' post of Chief Engineer, Recruitment Rules, 2005.

(2) They shall come into force on and from the date of their publication in the official gazette.

2. *Number of post, its classification and scale of pay.*—The number of the said post, its classification and the scale of pay attached thereto shall be as specified in columns 2 to 4 of the Schedule annexed hereto.

3. *Method of recruitment, age limit and other qualifications, etc.*—The method of recruitment to the said post, age limit, qualifications and other matters relating thereto, shall be as specified in columns 5 to 14 of the said Schedule.

4. *Disqualifications.*—No person,—

(a) who has entered into or contracted a marriage with a person having a spouse living; or

(b) who, having a spouse living, has entered into or contracted a marriage with any person,

shall be eligible for appointment to the said post:

Provided that the Lieutenant-Governor may, if satisfied that such marriage is permissible under the personal law applicable to such person and the other party to the marriage and there are other grounds for so doing, exempt any person from the operation of this rule.

5. *Power to relax.*—Where the Lieutenant-Governor, is of the opinion, that it is necessary or expedient so to do, he/she may, by order and for reasons to be recorded in writing and in consultation with the Union Public Service Commission relax any of the provisions of these rules with respect to any class or category of persons.

6. *Savings.*—Nothing in these rules shall affect the reservations, relaxations in upper age limit and other concessions required to be provided for the scheduled castes, the scheduled tribes and other special categories of persons in accordance with the orders issued by the Government from time to time in this regard.

RECRUITMENT RULES FOR THE POST OF CHIEF ENGINEER

In case of recruitment by promotion/deputation/absorption grades from which promotion/deputation/absorption is to be made. : Promotion : Superintending Engineer (Rs. 12,000-16,500) with five years regular service in the grade, failing which Superintending Engineer with ten years of combined regular service in the grade of Superintending Engineer and Executive Engineer out of which at least one year regular service should be in the grade of Superintending Engineer.

NOTE: Where juniors who have completed their qualifying/eligibility service are being considered for promotion, their seniors would also be considered provided they are not short of the requisite qualifying/eligibility service by more than half of such qualifying/eligibility service or two years whichever is less and have successfully completed their probation period for promotion to the next higher grade alongwith their juniors who have already completed such qualifying/eligibility service.

Deputation :

Officers under the Central/State Governments/Union Territories:

(a) (i) holding analogous post on regular basis in the parent cadre/department; or

(ii) with five years service in the grade rendered after appointment thereto on a regular basis in the scale of pay of Rs. 12,000-16,500 or equivalent in the parent cadre/department; and

(b) possessing the following qualifications and experience

Essential :

(i) Degree in Civil Engineering from a recognized University or equivalent.

(ii) 12 years professional experience in the field of Civil Engineering works.

Desirable :

Post-graduate Degree in Civil Engineering from a recognized University or equivalent. (The departmental officers in the feeder category who are in the direct line of promotion will not be eligible for consideration for appointment on deputation. Similarly deputationists shall not be eligible for consideration for appointment by promotion).

(Period of deputation including period of deputation in another ex-cadre post held immediately preceding this appointment in the same or some other organization/ department of the Central Government shall ordinarily not exceed five years. The maximum age limit for appointment by deputation shall be not exceeding 56 years as on the closing date of the receipt of applications).
