NOTIFICATION

In exercise of the powers conferred under the proviso to article 309 of the Constitution of India, read with the Notification No. 5/4/65-GP., dated 11th January 1965 of the Government of India, Ministry of Home Affairs, New Delhi, the Lieutenant-Governor, Pondicherry hereby makes the following rules further to amend the Government of Pondicherry, Public Works Department, Class-III (Technical) Recruitment Rules, 1965 issued in Notification No. 17843/Dev./PW/F/64, dated 31st January 1966 of Planning and Development Department, Pondicherry and published in the Supplement to the Gazette No. 27, dated 5th July 1966, in so far as it relates to the posts of Draughtsman Grade-II, namely :-

1. *Short title and commencement.*— (1) These rules may be called the Government of Pondicherry Public Works Department, Class-III (Technical) Recruitment (Amendment) Rules, 2005

(2) They shall come into force on and from the date of their publication in the official gazette.

2. *Amendment to Schedule-III.*—In the Government of Pondicherry, Public Works Department, Class-III (Technical) Recruitment Rules, 1965, in Schedule-III for the existing entries, the following shall be substituted, namely:-

SCHEDULE -III

RECRUITMENT RULES FOR THE POST OF DRAUGHTSMAN GRADE-II

1. Name of the post	:	Draughtsman Grade-II.
2. Number of posts	:	52 (Fifty-two) [2005] Subject to variation dependent on work-load.
3. Classification	:	General-Central Services-Group 'C' Non-Gazetted-Non-Ministerial
4. Scale of pay	:	Rs. 5,000-150-8,000
5. Whether selection or non-selection	:	Non-selection
6. Whether benefit of added years of service is admissible under rule 30 of the Central Civil Services (Pension) Rules, 1972.	:	Does not arise
7. Age limit for direct recruits	:	Between 18 and 32 years (Upper age limit relaxable for Government servants up to 40 years in accordance with the orders or instructions issued by the Government, provided such Government servants are working for not less than 3 years in the posts which are in the same line or a line of cadres and where a relationship can be established that the services rendered by them in the department will be useful for efficient discharge of duties in the post for which selection is made).

Note : The crucial date for determining the age limit in case of recruitment through Employment Exchange, is the last date by which Employment Exchange is requested to furnish nominations.

8. Educational and other qualifications required for direct recruits : **Essential :**
Three years Diploma in Civil Engineering awarded by the Board of Technical Examinations / any other Institutions recognised by the Government
Desirable :
A Degree in Civil Engineering awarded by Institutions of recognised Universities.
9. Whether age and educational qualification prescribed for direct recruits will apply in the case of promotees. : **Age :** No
Qualification : Essential qualification only is applicable to promotees.
10. Period of probation, if any : Two years
11. Method of recruitment, whether by direct recruitment or by promotion or by deputation/absorption and percentage of the post to be filled by various methods. : (i) 50 % by direct recruitment.
(ii) 50 % by promotion, failing which by direct recruitment
12. In case of recruitment by promotion / deputation/absorption, grades from which promotion/deputation/transfer is to be made. : Promotion from Overseer (Junior Senior Grade) with 8 years of service in the grade rendered after appointment thereto on regular basis failing which, from Work Inspector with 16 years of service in the Grade rendered after appointment thereto on regular basis.
13. If a Departmental Promotion Committee / Recruitment Committee exists, what is its composition? : **Departmental Promotion Committee/Recruitment Committee for Group 'C' posts consisting of —**
(i) Secretary to Government (Works) . . . Chairman
(ii) Joint/Deputy/Under Secretary to Government (Works) . . . Member
(iii) Chief Engineer, Public Works Department . . . Member
14. Circumstances in which Union Public Service Commission is to be consulted in making recruitment. : Not applicable
