

GOVERNMENT OF PONDICHERRY

NOTIFICATION

In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to article 309 of the Constitution of India, read with the Notification No. F5/465-GP, dated the 11th January, 1965 of the Government of India, Ministry of Home Affairs, New Delhi, the Lieutenant-Governor, Pondicherry hereby makes the following rules regarding the method of recruitment to the Group 'B' post of Bio-Chemist in the Public Works Department, Pondicherry, namely:—

1. Short title and commencement.—(1) These rules may be called the Government of Pondicherry, Public Works Department, Group 'B' Post of Bio-Chemist Recruitment Rules, 1995

(2) They shall come into force on and from the date of their publication in the official gazette.

2. Number of post, its classification and scale of pay.—The number of the said post, its classification and the scale of pay attached thereto shall be as specified in columns 2 to 4 of the Schedule annexed hereto.

3. Method of recruitment, age limit and other qualifications.—The method of recruitment to the said post, age limit, qualifications and other matters relating thereto shall be as specified in columns 5 to 14 of the said Schedule.

4. Disqualifications.— No person,—

(a) who has entered into or contracted a marriage with a person having a spouse living; or

(b) who, having a spouse living, has entered into or contracted a marriage with any person, shall be eligible for appointment to the said post;

Provided that the Lieutenant-Governor may, if satisfied that such marriage is permissible under the personal law applicable to such person and the other party to the marriage and there are other grounds for so doing, exempt any person from the operation of this rule.

Power to relax.—Where the Lieutenant-Governor is of the opinion that it is necessary or expedient so to do, he may, by order in consultation with the Union Public Service Commission and for reasons to be recorded in writing, relax any of the provisions of these rules with respect to any class or category of persons.

Saving.—Nothing in these rules shall affect the reservation, relaxation in upper age limit and other concessions required to be provided for the scheduled castes, the scheduled tribes and other special category of persons in accordance with the orders issued by the Government from time to time in this regard.

4. *Disqualifications.*—(1) No person,—

(a) who has entered into or contracted a marriage with a person having a spouse living; or

(b) who, having a spouse living, has entered into or contracted a marriage with any person, shall be eligible for appointment to the said post:

Provided that the Lieutenant-Governor may, if satisfied that such marriage is permissible under the personal law applicable to such person and the other party to the marriage and there are no other grounds for so doing, exempt any person from the operation of this rule.

5. *Power to relax.*— Where the Lieutenant-Governor, is of the opinion that it is necessary or expedient so to do, he may, by order, and for reasons to be recorded in writing and in consultation with the Union Public Service Commission relax any of the provisions of these rules with respect to any class or category of persons.

6. *Saving.*— Nothing in these rules shall affect the reservations, relaxations in upper age limit and other concessions required to be provided for the scheduled castes, the scheduled tribes and other special category of persons in accordance with the orders issued by the Government from time to time in this regard.

SCHEDULE

RIVISED RECRUITMENT RULES FOR THE POST OF PRINCIPAL ENGINEER, SUPERINTENDING ENGINEER

1. Name of the post	(i) Principal Engineer (ii) Superintending Engineer
2. Number of the posts	4 (Four) [1995] Subject to variation dependent on work-load.
3. Classification	General Central Services--Group 'A'--Gazetted--Non-Ministerial.
4. Scale of pay	Rs. 3,700-125-4,700-150-5,000.
5. Whether selection post or non-selection post	Selection ✓
6. Age limit for direct recruits	Not applicable. ✓
7. Whether benefit of added years of service admissible under rule 30 of the Central Civil Services (Pension) Rules, 1972.	Not applicable. ✓
8. Educational and other qualifications required for direct recruits	Not applicable. ✓
9. Whether educational and other qualifications prescribed for direct recruits will apply in the case of promotions.	Not applicable.
10. Period of reservation, if any	Not applicable.
11. Method of recruitment, whether by direct recruitment or by promotion or by deputation/transfer and percentage of vacancies to be filled by various methods.	Promotion, filling which by transfer on deputation. Note: Senior-most Superintending Engineer in the Public Works Department, Pooncherry will be designated as Principal Engineer.

12. In case of recruitment by promotion/deputation/transfer, grades from which promotion/deputation/transfer is to be made.

Promotion:

Executive Engineer in the Public Works Department, Pondicherry with 5 years regular service in the grade.

Transfer on deputation:

Officers of the Central/State Governments/Union Territories—

- (a) (i) holding analogous posts on a regular basis; or
 (ii) with 5 years regular service in posts in the scale of pay of Rs. 3,000-4,500 or equivalent; and
 (b) possessing a Degree in Civil Engineering from a recognised University or equivalent with 10 years' professional experience.

The departmental officers in the feeder category who are in the direct line of promotion shall not be eligible for consideration for appointment on deputation.

Similarly, deputationists shall not be eligible for consideration for appointment by promotion.

[Period of deputation, including period of deputation in another ex-cadre post held immediately preceding this appointment in the same or some other organisation/department of the Central Government shall ordinarily not to exceed four years. The maximum age limit for appointment by transfer on deputation (including short-term contract), transfer shall be not exceeding 59 years as on the closing date of receipt of applications].

13. In a Departmental Promotion Committee/Recruitment Committee exists, what is its composition?

Group 'A' Departmental Promotion Committee (for considering promotion):

- (1) Chairman/Member, Union Public Service Commission. Chairman.
 (2) Chief Secretary. Member.
 (3) Secretary (Works). Member.

Group 'A' Departmental Promotion Committee (for considering confirmation):

- (1) Chief Secretary. Chairman.
 (2) Secretary (Works). Member.

Note: The proceedings of the Departmental Promotion Committee relating to confirmation of a direct recruits shall be sent to the Commission for approval. If however, these are not approved by the Commission a fresh meeting of the Departmental Promotion Committee to be presided over by the Chairman or a Member of the Union Public Service Commission shall be held.

14. Circumstances in which Union Public Service Commission is to be consulted in making recruitment?

Consultation with the Union Public Service Commission is necessary while appointing an officer on transfer on deputation.
